

## **Glass Cleaning and Maintenance**

This information is offered as general information only. Specific advice on the cleaning of glass should always be sought from a reputable glazier or professional window cleaner before any glass cleaning is undertaken.

## How to clean glass with a Low E coating?

- Make sure to remove any jewellery that may scratch the surface of the glass.
- Spray on a clear liquid window cleaner, such as clear Windex or a mixture of 1 part vinegar to ten parts water (no coloured liquids)
- Use a lint free cloth to wipe over window
- To prevent streaking, stop wiping when the glass is almost dry and there is a uniform residue of moisture left on the glass surface. The residue will quickly evaporate leaving a clean surface.

## How to clean standard glass, toughened glass and most double glazing?

 Use the same steps as above. This method can be used for all glass to avoid damage to the window.

## **Spot Cleaning:**

- Make sure to remove any jewellery that may scratch the surface of the glass.
- Apply a small quantity of Methylated Spirits to a clean, wet cloth or towel. (Please use strictly in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations and warnings)
- Rub on areas of glass needing spot cleaning.
- Wipe clean using a dry, clean, lint free towel or cloth followed by a routine cleaning procedure.
